



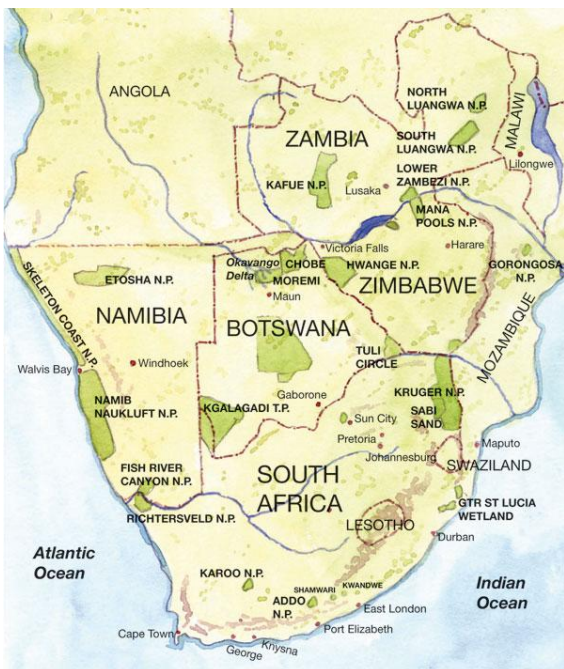
Dr. Rich is moving to Africa

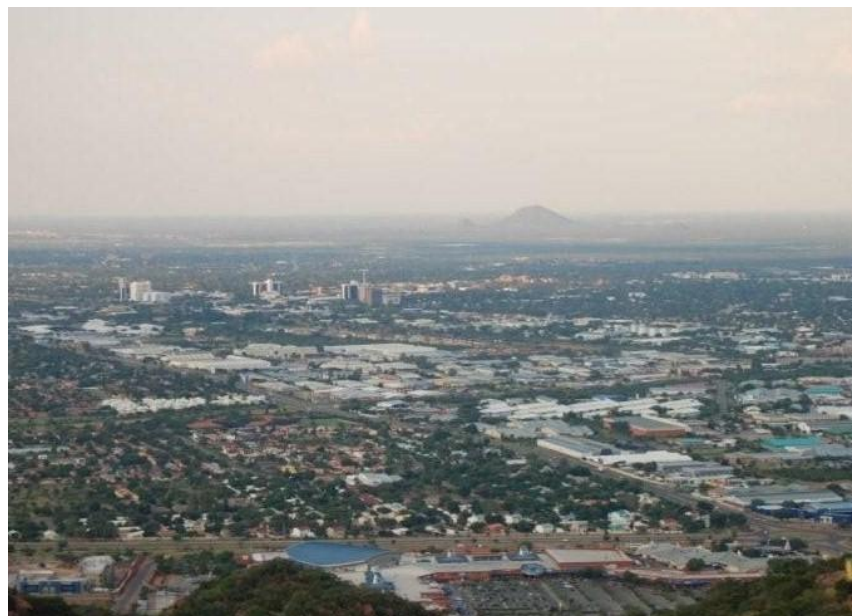
His plans include working for the Ministry of Health of Botswana as the only pediatrician in a county hospital 20 miles outside the capital, which serves a population of 60,000. He will care for the inpatient pediatric patients and newborns, as well as have a general pediatric clinic and a pediatric HIV clinic. Botswana just started its own pediatric residency program this January, and Dr. Rich will likely be helping train the future pediatricians of Botswana, and hopefully, his replacement.

It has been very difficult for Dr. Rich in leaving Cherry Creek, but he has been very appreciative of all the support from his patients and their families. He wishes to thank them for all their hard work in caring for their children's health, and letting him be a part of that team.
