

Transparency in Health Care Prices Act – 15 Most Common Services

In compliance with Colorado Revised Statute: 25-49-103 – Transparency in Health Care Prices Act which requires greater transparency in provider prices enabling consumers to be better informed, Cherry Creek Pediatrics is disclosing to consumers our charges for the 15 most common services we provide when payment is made directly by the patients rather than by a third party.

The health care price for any given health care service is an estimate and that the actual charges for the health care service are dependent on the circumstances at the time the service is rendered.

If you are covered by health insurance, you are strongly encouraged to consult with your health insurer to determine accurate information about your financial responsibility for a particular health care service provided by a health care provider at this office. If you are not covered by health insurance, you are strongly encouraged to contact our billing office at 303-756-0101 to discuss payment options prior to receiving a health care service from a health care provider at this office since posted health care prices may not reflect the actual amount of your financial responsibility.

87880	Streptococcus, group A. Infectious agent antigen detection by immunoassay with direct optical observation.	\$30
90460	Immunization administration through 18 years of age via any route of administration, with counseling by physician or other health care professional; first or only component of each vaccine or toxoid administered.	\$51
90461	Immunization administration through 18 years of age via any route of administration, with counseling by physician or other health care professional; each additional vaccine or toxoid component administered.	\$24
90471	Immunization administration (includes percutaneous intradermal, subcutaneous, or intramuscular injections); 1 vaccine (single or combination vaccine/toxoid) without physician counseling	\$40
90686	Influenza virus vaccine, quadrivalent (IIV4), split virus, preservative free, .5mL dosage, for intramuscular use.	\$36
96110	Developmental screening (eg, developmental milestone survey, speech and language delay screen), with scoring and documentation, per standardized instrument.	\$26
96127	Brief emotional/behavioral assessment (eg, depression inventory, attention-deficit/hyperactivity disorder [ADHD] scale), with scoring and documentation, per standardized instrument.	\$19
99173	Screening test of visual acuity, quantitative, bilateral.	\$15
99213	Office or other outpatient visit for the evaluation and management of an established patient, which requires at least 2 of these 3 key components: An expanded problem focused history; An expanded problem focused examination; Medical decision making of low complexity. Counseling and coordination of care with other physicians, other qualified health care professionals, or agencies are provided consistent with the nature of the problem(s) and the patient's and/or family's needs. Usually, the presenting problem(s) are of low to moderate severity.	\$115

99214	Office or other outpatient visit for the evaluation and management of an established patient, which requires at least 2 of these 3 key components: A detailed history; A detailed examination; Medical decision making of moderate complexity. Counseling and/or coordination of care with other physicians, other qualified health care professionals, or agencies are provided consistent with the nature of the problem(s) and the patient's and/or family's needs. Usually, the presenting problem(s) are of moderate to high severity.	\$175
99391	Periodic comprehensive preventive medicine reevaluation and management of an individual including an age and gender appropriate history, examination, counseling/anticipatory guidance/risk factor reduction interventions, and the ordering of laboratory/diagnostic procedures, established patient; infant (age younger than 1 year).	\$155
99392	Periodic comprehensive preventive medicine reevaluation and management of an individual including an age and gender appropriate history, examination, counseling/anticipatory guidance/risk factor reduction interventions, and the ordering of laboratory/diagnostic procedures, established patient; early childhood (age 1 through 4 years).	\$170
99393	Periodic comprehensive preventive medicine reevaluation and management of an individual including an age and gender appropriate history, examination, counseling/anticipatory guidance/risk factor reduction interventions, and the ordering of laboratory/diagnostic procedures, established patient; late childhood (age 5 through 11 years).	\$170
